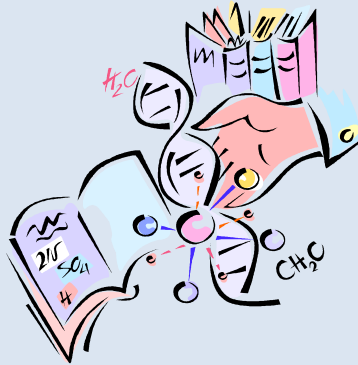

April 23rd

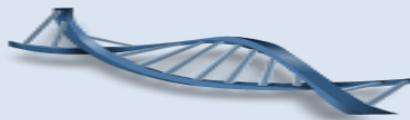
