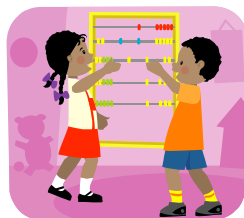


OUTSTANDING RESULTS ON STATE MATH EXAM

**STUDENTS PASSING AT LEVELS 3 & 4 CONFIRM CSEE HAVING BECOME
A TOP PERFORMING NEW YORK STATE SCHOOL IN MATH!**



(May 2009) Students at the Charter School of Educational Excellence have become top performers in math as evidence by test scores released by the State Education Department today on the New York Mathematics Assessments.

100% of the students in third grade at CSEE passed the state exam performing at Levels 3 and 4. This is another exceptional climb in student performance from 84% of students meeting and exceeding standards in math last year (2008).

Fourth grade passing at **96%** and sixth grade scoring at **95%** came close to perfect scores along with our third graders this year. Fifth grade showed the most remarkable improvement from last year where students showed a passing rate of 58% (2008) compared to this year (2009) where **91%** of the students demonstrate a mastery level in math.

The rapid academic achievements demonstrated over the years at CSEE is directly linked to the teamwork and collaboration led by committed administrators and teachers. The love, support, and nurturing students receive at the school makes CSEE the school of choice for many parents throughout Westchester and New York City.

Similar to the ELA results this year, CSEE's 2009 math test scores reflect double-digit percentage increases with more students achieving mastery in all grade levels tested. The Math Performance Index below shows how successful CSEE has been in closing the achievement gap in math over the course of three academic school years.
