TO JUDGE SCIENCE FAIR PROJECTS AT
CHARTER SCHOOL OF EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE**

Regeneron partners with the Charter School of Educational Excellence to judge science fair projects for 350 students in Kindergarten through sixth grade on **Thursday, May 21, 2009** between **9:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.**

Regeneron is a biopharmaceutical company that discovers, develops, and commercializes medicines for the treatment of serious medical conditions. Two teams of scientists volunteered to listen to presentations and judge the quality of science projects created by classes and individual students at the school. Scientists on Team I will be assigned to judge early childhood classes (K-2) and Scientists on Team II will judge science projects for students in Grades 3-6. During their visit, the scientists will engage students in interactive discussions about their experiments and results and help students develop a deeper understanding of their scientific investigations.

Bringing real life scientists into the classrooms will be an exciting way for our students to discover how interesting science is when they come face to face with real-life trained professionals who will challenge their thinking and scientific investigations in a meaningful and thought-provoking way.
